Talk How do you think Jesus' friends felt when Jesus said this to them?

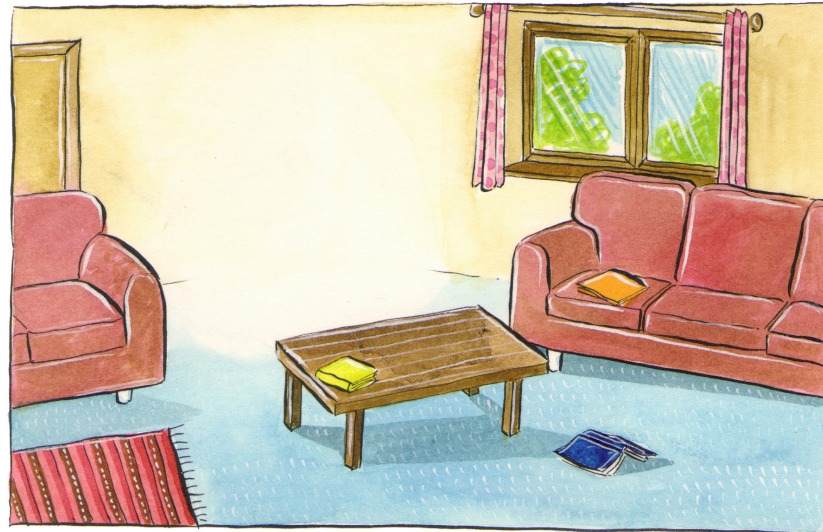
Do Each morning this week, read Mark 13.32-35 and talk about how you can be ready for Jesus that day.
